Below are answers to each of the 15 'Fast facts quiz questions' on Alex's favourite 'Australia – it's awesome' facts provided on a separate sheet.

- 1. Australia's official name is the 'Commonwealth of Australia'.
- Australia has about 150 volcanos.
- 3. Australia has about 10,685 beaches.
- 4. The Great Barrier Reef is so large that it can be seen from space.
- 5. The first Police Officers in Australia were convicts that were deemed to be very well-behaved.
- 6. South Australian women were voting in their state elections from the year 1894.
- 7. When Saudi Arabia need camels, they buy them from Australia.
- 8. Of Australia's 769.2 million hectares of land, our farmers manage approximately 51%.
- 9. Australian farmers produce around 93% of all the fresh food eaten in Australia.
- 10. Five of the competition entries to design our Australian flag were so close in design that they were all awarded equal first- place.
- 11. It is thought that about 250 different Aboriginal groups, each with their own language live in Australia today.
- 12. Close to 30% of Australia's population were born overseas.
- 13. The largest number of immigrants have come to Australia from England (about 4%).
- 14. Approximately 1,000,000 camels are thought to be wandering around outback Australia.
- 15. The first word, 'Waltzing' is Australian slang for 'travelling on foot' and the word 'Matilda' is slang for 'swag' which refers to a rolled-up blanket that people travelling around Australia on foot or horseback carried to sleep in.
