- 4. What is the most popular type of banana grown in Australia today?
- 5. What is the name of the type of banana that is commonly grown in Aussie backyards?
- 6. Bananas do not grow on trees but on a 'non-woody stem' what?
- 7. Banana plants are officially referred to as what?
- 8. Approximately how many different varieties of banana plants grow around the world?
- 9. How long does a banana plant take to produce its first bunch of bananas?
- 10. How many bananas are you likely to find in an average bunch hanging on the banana plant and how much is the bunch likely to weigh?
- 11. Today, what percentage of bananas grown in Australia come from around Tully and Innisfail in north Queensland?
- 12. Why is it important to keep overseas bananas out of Australia?
- 13. How much water can be found in a peeled banana?
- 14. Why are bananas bent?
- 15. Left to ripen naturally on their plants, organic bananas are usually picked how many days before they go to the market?
