Below are the answers to each of the 15 'Fast facts quiz questions' provided on a separate sheet.

- 1. The main job of the queen bee is to lay eggs so there are always new bees to keep the hive alive.
- 2. The main job of drone bees is to mate with the queen bee.
- 3. One hive of bees can have up to 80,000 bees.
- 4. Worker bees only live for about 42 45 days.
- 5. Around 35% of crops grown in Australia need bees for pollination.
- 6. Bees can beat their wings around 200 times per second.
- 7. On average, a hive of bees can produce up to 27kg of honey.
- 8. Around 4,000 tonnes of Australian honey is exported overseas every year.
- 9. If kept in an airtight container, it is said that honey will not go off.
- 10. You can tell whether a jar of honey is Australian by reading the label.
- 11. A bee's buzzing noise is made when it flaps its wings rapidly.
- 12. Drone bees are referred to as 'lazy' because they even hold their tongues out for worker bees to put food on it.
- 13. A worker bee can carry a huge 70 milligrams of nectar on its body.
- 14. Honey has reportedly been found in Egyptian tombs, dating back thousands of years.
- 15. Beekeepers leave plenty of honey behind in the hive to feed young bees and all members of the hive during winter.
